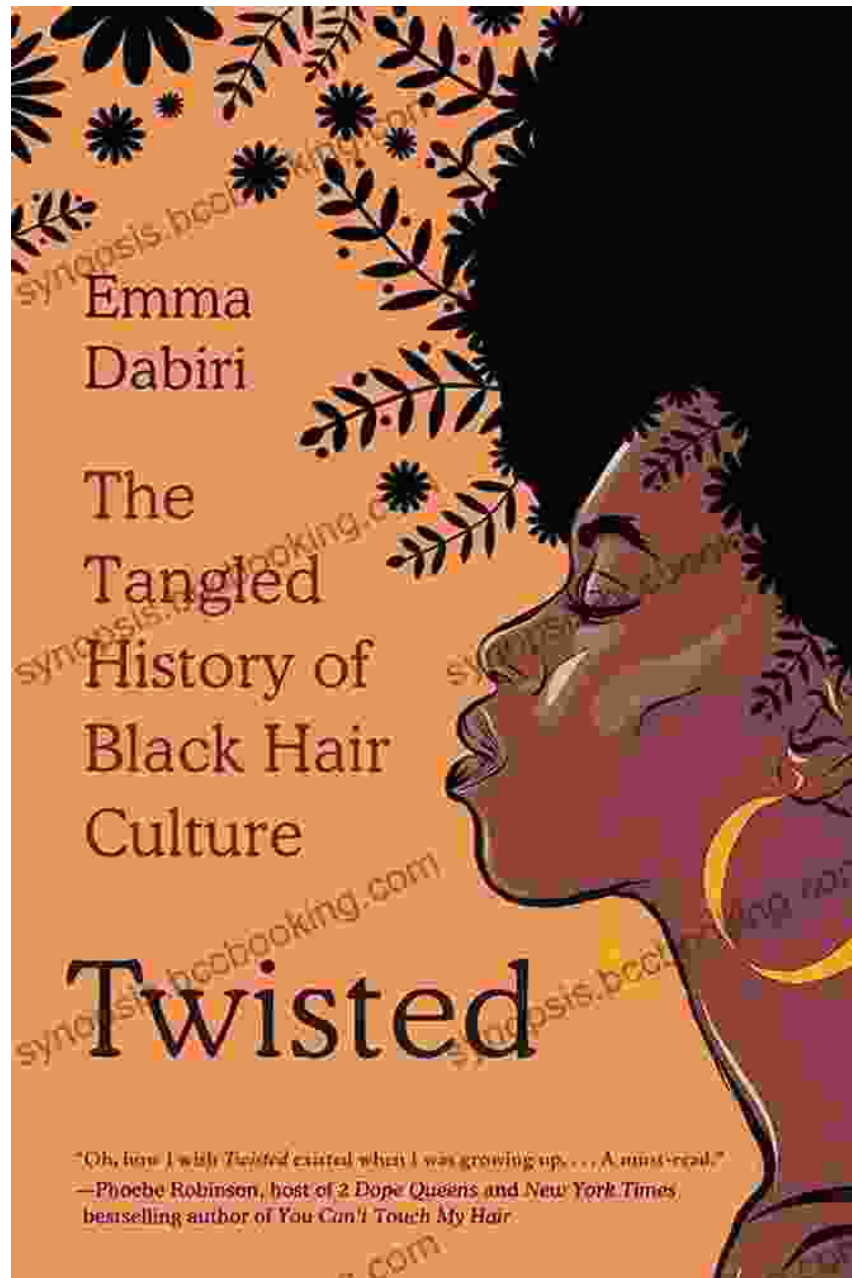


Twisted: The Tangled History of Black Hair Culture

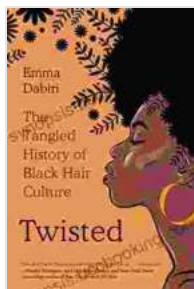

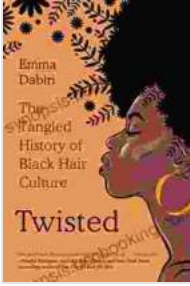

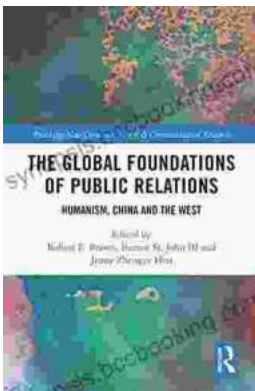
